The Association

“Sur le chemin de Robert Louis Stevenson”

The path pioneered by Robert Louis Stevenson in 1878 links the départements of Haute-Loire, Ardèche, Lozère and Gard, deep in the Massif Central, and offers daily discoveries and surprises.

The association “Sur le Chemin de Robert Louis Stevenson” was created in 1994 with the aim of promoting this itinerary and helping the constantly growing number of walkers to plan their trip on the GR®70 from Le Puy-en-Velay to Alès.

The Association is a network with a people-centred approach numbering over 200 professionals from the commercial, tourism and cultural sectors, based from Le Puy-en-Velay to Alès. They own accommodation and restaurants, hire out donkeys, organise your holiday, supply cultural speakers and hiking guides, manage cultural sites, transport people and luggage, run shops and provide services. They are all located on or near the Trail. In this brochure, you'll find all the details you need to prepare your adventure in the way that suits you best!

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Robert Louis Stevenson

“avant-garde” hiker!

On 22 September 1878, the young Scottish writer Robert Louis Stevenson left Le-Monastier-sur-Gazeille (Haute-Loire) with his donkey Modestine. Twelve days, two-hundred-and-twenty kilometres and many adventures later, he arrived at Saint-Jean-du-Gard.

He had two reasons for that trip: to recover from the return to America of Fanny Osbourne (whom he would eventually marry a few years later), and to discover the land of the Protestant Camisards...

His book entitled *Travels with a Donkey in the Cévennes* -largely inspired by his travel diary- was published in 1879, followed a few years later by the famous *Treasure Island* and *The Strange Case of Dr Jekyll and Mr Hyde*.

This book has made it possible to trace his route, which has since become the Stevenson Trail (GR® 70 Le Chemin de Stevenson). This marked public hiking trail enables walkers to follow in the footsteps of the Francophile Scottish adventurer.

Best practices

Towards responsible tourism

Whether you are a long-distance walker or just a short-term visitor, you can play your part in the conservation of these invaluable treasures if you abide by some common sense rules.

You can thereby contribute to the protection of the environment, the natural heritage, the local population and its activities, and your fellow-walkers.

Your tolerant and eco-friendly attitude will ensure that future generations will find this countryside in the same condition as it was when Stevenson discovered it over a century ago.

- Respect nature and do not leave any waste behind, even if it is biodegradable.
- For your natural needs, dig a hole about 10 to 15 cm deep and cover it with soil; before leaving, take the toilet paper with you.
- Stay on the path.
- Do not let dogs follow you.
- Do not feed the animals.
- Ask the owners for permission to camp (in a shed, a meadow, etc.).
- Close gates behind you.
- Keep your distance from animals and go around herds whenever possible.
- If you encounter a guard dog: stay calm, slowly turn around or stop, do not try to pet it (it could interpret this as aggression). Once it has ascertained your good intentions, it should move away.
- Find out before you set off that you will be crossing protected areas.
- Avoid fires.

Useful tips

The Stevenson Trail is a mid-altitude trail. Even though it does not present any particular dangers (dizzyingly steep sections, etc.), it is nonetheless a wilderness trail: often stony, at times muddy, and consisting of a succession of uphill and downhill stretches with at times substantial changes in altitude, which require hikers to be in good physical shape. Hikers must wear appropriate footwear for walking on the uneven ground and be equipped according to the weather forecast. They must also set off with food and water reserves that are adapted to the hike. Whilst the Stevenson Trail is way-marked, it crosses many GR^o, and you will need a guidebook and/or maps to orientate yourself properly.

The logo of the association indicates accommodation open in the winter. ❄️

However, beware of setting off without careful planning. You will be walking at an altitude of between 700 and 1700 m so it is essential to be correctly equipped for very cold temperatures, to prepare your route in detail, to know how to read a map, to use a compass, to have a mobile phone and a satnav (GPS) in case the trail markers are covered in snow. The weather is sometimes uncertain, snow storms are unlike other storms and require a good knowledge of mountains in winter ! Let's set off for an adventure !

Bed bugs

“Better information means a better combat”



Over the last few years, bed bugs have spread all over France in all types of professional and private accommodation. Their presence in no way reflects a lack of hygiene.

A bed bug is a nocturnal insect which feeds on human blood. Their bites are similar to mosquito bites, but are either grouped together or in line. They can be irritant or not, depending on the sensitivity of each person. Bed bugs are usually found on the edge or inside bed sheets. Unfortunately, they also find their way into your luggage and are transported elsewhere.

The best friend of bed bugs is silence. If you don't speak about them, they will proliferate..

Good reflexes to fight the spread:

During the hike:

- Isolate your belongings in an airtight bag and separate your sleepwear and sleeping gear in an airtight bag separate from the rest.
- Preventively treat your down, luggage and personal effects (inside / outside)
- Regularly inspect bedding and bed linen (signs: small black dots and black or red streaks)
- Communicate: In the event of bites or doubts about the possible presence of bedbugs in accommodation, do not hesitate to speak to the host.

When you come back:

- You may be asked not to bring your bags and suitcases into the rooms.
- Wash everything that passes at 60°C, dryer, iron at 180°C steam if you have a +++ appliance.
- Freezing - 20 ° 72 hours minimum
- or put everything in quarantine in an airtight bag with diatomaceous earth.



Getting There

Before you set off, consider how to fit your trip around the availability of transport. Hikers often find that transport is a problem in organising their trip. The Stevenson Trail both starts and finishes at SNCF railway stations (at le Puy-en-Velay and Alès) to make the GR70 more accessible.

NB: the GR70 goes through small villages which don't all have a train or bus service. Car sharing is another possibility! You can research this via the various dedicated websites.

- A well-enclosed, accessible, and well-maintained enclosure of at least 50 m², presenting no risk to the donkeys and located as close as possible to the accommodation (less than 1 km).
- Good quality hay, in sufficient quantity for them to be able to eat throughout the night... Barley or pellets are only a supplement and are not sufficient. A salt block and clean water at will.
- providing a sheltered area to store donkey equipment overnight.
- knowing the telephone numbers of nearby veterinarians.




Accommodation, food and services

Nearly all accommodation is open from mid March to early November; outside this period please consult the detailed entries for each accommodation on the website: www.chemin-stevenson.org You are strongly advised to reserve in advance.

Note that reception for hikers on arrival is preferably from 16h00 onwards. The 200 or so accommodation providers in this brochure are committed to providing services which are of good quality, but different and complementary, so that hikers can each find the type of accommodation that suits them best, whether it be in hostels, bed-and-breakfasts, hotels, campsites or holiday chalets, caravans etc. The variety on offer is part of the charm of the Stevenson trail. Before completing your reservations, we strongly recommend that you make contact with each potential host, who will be able to advise you on your proposed stages.

The maps in this brochure show the trail's four geographical regions, but be aware that their purpose is to help you plan your stages and your overnight stops, they are in no way a walking map! The key to the icons used is on the inside cover flap.

If you find that the accommodation you want is already fully booked out, have you considered modifying your departure date?

In Stevenson's tracks across Europe

Louis Stevenson like many another young Briton of his social class travelled frequently in Europe, participating in the so-called grand tour which gave rise to the notion of tourism. In search of "healthy air" for his respiratory illness, he and his family stayed in health resorts and spas, notably at Hyères and Menton in southern France as well as Bad Godesburg in Germany and Davos in Switzerland.

As an adult he undertook a trip through Belgium and northern France by sailing canoe, down the rivers and canals from Antwerp to Pontoise near Paris. In the artists' colonies of the forest of Fontainebleau he met Fanny, the love of his life; then he crossed the Cévennes on foot with the donkey Modestine. He drew inspiration for his writing from landscapes in Britain too, such as Bristol and its docks for *Treasure Island*, or the Lothian region and especially North Berwick and the Edinburgh of his childhood, and the Scottish Highlands, the setting for his famous novel *Kidnapped*.

In all these places, Stevenson's work and memory live on thanks to devoted and passionate admirers and their many and varied actions – museums, audio trails using mobile apps, cycleways, walking trails, canoe and riverboat trips... where you may encounter the author in a range of different ways, including a board game.

All those involved here, and their territories, are part of the Association "In the footsteps of Robert Louis Stevenson", which has been certified since 2015 as one of the Council of Europe's Cultural Itineraries.


